**Canberra Potters' Society** was established in 1975 and has grown since then to become a vibrant, energetic organization serving the needs of potters and people interested in ceramics in the ACT region. Its objectives are to encourage and foster the development, appreciation and recognition of pottery made by individual craftspeople and designers in a ceramic medium and to provide for the professional development of its members. The Society is a not-for-profit community group.

As an ACT Government *Key Arts Organization*, the Society manages **Watson Arts Centre**, an ACT Government arts facility. In addition to the Society's workshops and other facilities, the Centre has a spacious gallery with a continually changing exhibition program, a pottery retail outlet, studios available to let to ceramic artists and a studio and residence dedicated to an artist-in-residence program.

**Membership fees** are payable annually and are as stated on the application form forming part of this brochure.

**Members' Events** are held at regular intervals during the year and are publicised in the Society's newsletter, on the web site, via email to members and on notice boards at Watson Arts Centre.

**Pottery classes** for adults and children are held over four terms each year. Children's holiday programs are held in the school holidays. General classes cover all aspects of pottery, handbuilding and wheelwork as well as glazing, decorating and firing. Advanced courses, such as glaze preparation, and beginners' courses are also run. Up-to-date course information may be obtained from the Society or the web site. It is not necessary to be a member to enrol in classes but members receive discounts on class fees, clay and firing costs.

**Workshops & master classes** given by national and international potters supplement the pottery class program and are offered at various times during the year.

Casual access to use the **workshop facilities** is available to members who satisfactorily complete a mandatory workshop orientation or annual refresher

session and abide by the workshop rules of use, including workshop health and safety requirements, as detailed in the 'Workshop Access and Health & Safety' handbook. The Workshop Managers can provide information about orientation sessions.

A Thursday morning semi-supervised **drop-in session** provides members with access to the main workshop facilities.

**Firing** of members' work is available at very reasonable 'per kg' prices that include both bisque and glaze firings and use of the Society's glazes.

**Kilns** are available for hire to members who successfully complete a kiln firing course or can otherwise prove their competency to pack and fire a kiln.

The Society's newsletter, **The Canberra Potter**, is produced each month except January and contains news of coming events and items of interest. Members are welcome to submit material for inclusion and may place pottery-related advertisements free of charge.

The Society has an extensive **library** of books and journals that may be borrowed by members.

Each year the Society holds a selected **exhibition** of members' work and two 'cash & carry' **fairs** that provide an outlet for members wishing to sell their work.

The Society's shop, **potters place**, stocks a variety of hand-made ceramics from selected members. Clay and tools are also available for purchase in the shop.
